The Role

Reporting to the Managing Director, the Construction Site Supervisor will be based primarily on a client site in Shannon, Co. Clare, with occasional travel to other client locations as required. The successful candidate will ensure that client requirements are fully understood, that works are delivered safely and in accordance with the drawings and specification, and that clear, accurate reporting is maintained to our Head Office.

Applicants must have experience supervising or monitoring the construction delivery of building and civil engineering projects up to €5m in value within Ireland, including mechanical and electrical work packages. The role involves day-to-day site monitoring, programme compliance checks, contractor oversight, safety and quality verification, and ensuring that works are delivered in line with client expectations, statutory requirements, and best practice.

The duties of the Construction Site Supervisor include:

- Ensure full compliance with safety, health, and environmental requirements at all times, promoting a strong safety culture on site.
- Monitor all site activities from mobilisation through to handover, ensuring works proceed in accordance with approved drawings and specifications
- Liaise closely with the Contractor's representatives to ensure accurate project handover and ongoing communication.
- Review and challenge construction programmes, sequencing, and resource planning where required.
- Monitor Contractor performance, ensuring adherence to specifications, quality standards, and programme requirements.
- Review drawings, specifications, and technical documentation to ensure buildability and compliance.
- Attend and chair meetings as required with the Contractor and other stakeholders.
- Track project progress, identify risks or delays early, and request corrective actions where necessary.
- Ensure adherence to client sustainability, procurement, and quality policies.
- Maintain detailed site records, including daily logs, quality inspections, photographs, and safety documentation.

- Work collaboratively as part of a wider team to ensure successful delivery of client objectives.
- Support client teams with progress updates, variation identification, and verification of completed works.
- Drive continuous improvement and foster a positive, proactive site environment.
- Prepare clear written reports using Microsoft Word, Excel, and other relevant software.
